ICD-10 Update:

- **Electronic Claims:** We have finished ICD-10 programming; we are now testing with Gateway EDI.
- **Paper Claims:** Support for paper claims is in the Latest Internet Update;
- **HCFA 1500:** After April 1st some insurance companies will only accept the newer 2012 CMS 1500 HCFA claim format. For these claims, you will need to purchase new claim forms and use the PowerSoftMD “HCFA 1500 2012 Version” option when printing claims.

Windows 8 – Tips & Tricks



← Located in the lower-left side of the keyboard, this is the “Windows Key”

- Press the Windows key to switch between desktop (looks like XP) and the new, tiled mode
- The Windows “Key” + “W” opens a search; you can type in the name of the program you’re looking for. Example: type in “calculator” to bring it up
